God's Simple Plan of Salvation

First, we must realize that we've all sinned. Romans 3:23 says, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

Second, the penalty for our sins is death and eternal separation from God. The Bible says in *Roman 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death."* and in *Ezekiel 18:20, "The soul that sinneth, it shall die."*

Third, Jesus paid our penalty for us. God sent His Son to suffer and die in our place on the Cross.

Romans 5:8 says, But God commended [showed] His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." He died, but three days later rose from the grave and is alive forevermore.

Fourth, God loves you and wants to save you from your sins. *"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."* John 3:16

However, each person must accept Christ personally to be saved from their own sins. Jesus said, *"I am the way, the truth, and the life: No man cometh unto the Father, but by me."* John 14:6 *"Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."* Acts 4:12

There is **NO** other way. Salvation is not through being good, keeping a moral code, being religious, or any other efforts of our own. Salvation is only through the Lord Jesus Christ. Only His blood can wash away our sins. (See *Romans 5:9; Ephesians 1:7*) We must repent and turn to God for salvation – "I tell you, Nay; but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." Luke 13:3

How can you accept Christ as your Saviour?

Romans 10:13 tells us, "For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved." John 1:12 says, "But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His Name."
